TESTIMONY: I would like to thank the people at Extreme Outreach for being there for me when I was in need. Extreme Outreach truly does God's work.

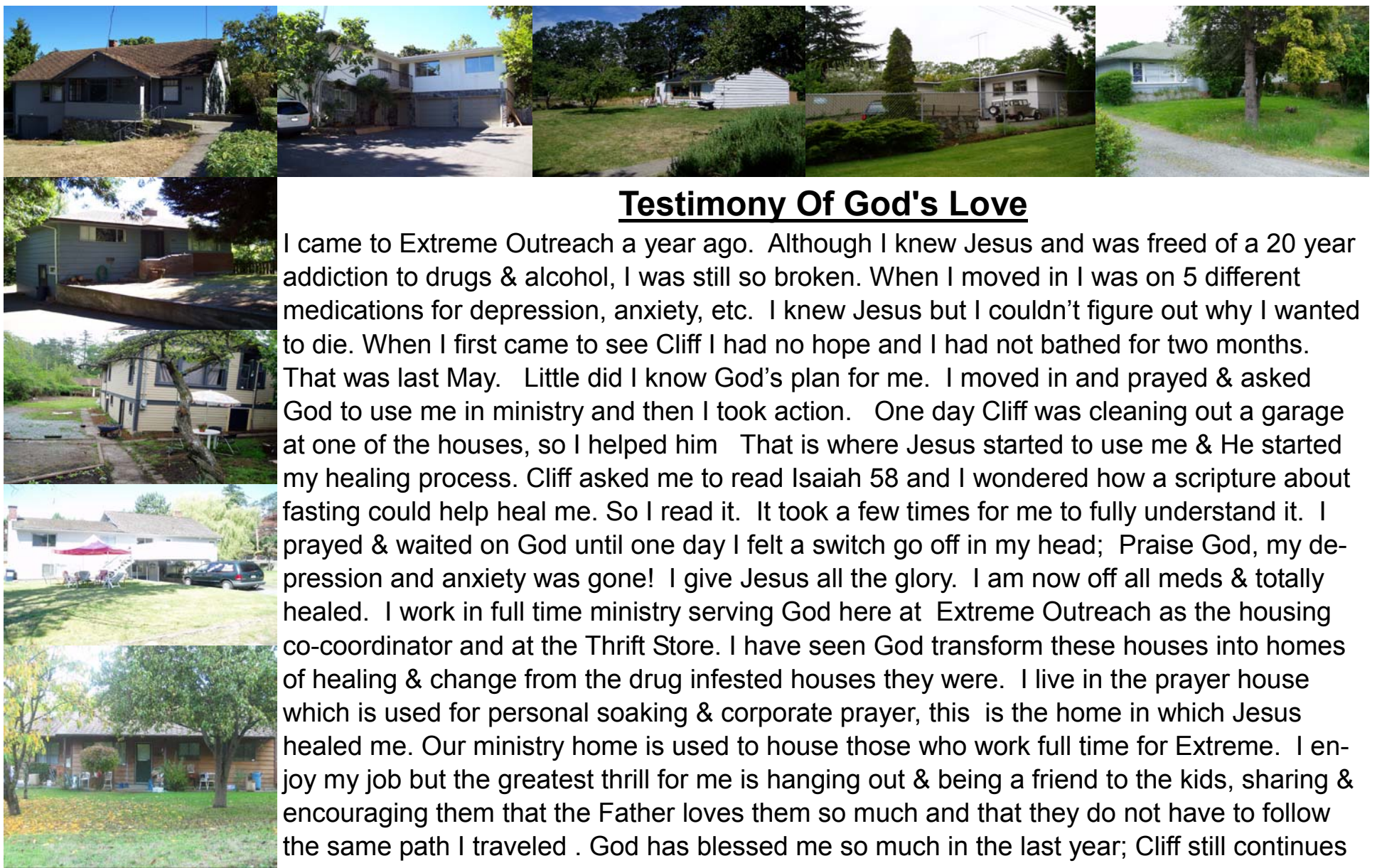

I came to Extreme Outreach a year ago. Although I knew Jesus and was freed of a 20 year addiction to drugs & alcohol, I was still so broken. When I moved in I was on 5 different medications for depression, anxiety, etc. I knew Jesus but I couldn't figure out why I wanted to die. When I first came to see Cliff I had no hope and I had not bathed for two months. That was last May. Little did I know God's plan for me. I moved in and prayed & asked God to use me in ministry and then I took action. One day Cliff was cleaning out a garage at one of the houses, so I helped him. That is where Jesus started to use me & He started my healing process. Cliff asked me to read Isaiah 58 and I wondered how a scripture about fasting could help heal me. So I read it. It took a few times for me to fully understand it. I prayed & waited on God until one day I felt a switch go off in my head; Praise God, my depression and anxiety was gone! I give Jesus all the glory. I am now off all meds & totally healed. I work in full time ministry serving God here at Extreme Outreach as the housing co-coordinator and at the Thrift Store. I have seen God transform these houses into homes of healing & change from the drug infested houses they were. I live in the prayer house which is used for personal soaking & corporate prayer, this is the home in which Jesus healed me. Our ministry home is used to house those who work full time for Extreme. I enjoy my job but the greatest thrill for me is hanging out & being a friend to the kids, sharing & encouraging them that the Father loves them so much and that they do not have to follow the same path I traveled. God has blessed me so much in the last year; Cliff still continues to be an amazing friend & mentor. I have awesome support & friendships with the team here at Extreme. God has given me so much grace & shown me His extravagant love since I have been here, I give Him all the glory. Darrell Craig
