

### Once a Superkid, always a Superkid

art of what makes our **Superkids** program unique is that kids don't ever grow out of being a Superkid. Since the program has been running for over ten years, we have relationships with several kids who have grown up in the program and surpassed the age 12 limit. Rather than saying goodbye, however, we create the opportunity for kids to continue to be mentored and to learn how to be a mentor by bringing them along as Junior Leaders and then Senior Leaders. One young woman, who started as a Superkid around age six, is now fourteen. Last camp, we brought her on board as part of our cleaning team (not super glamorous but still leaving enough extra time to hang at the lake and join in campfire and games!). She sent us the following comments afterwards:

**66** Superkids has taught me a lot how to treat myself and others. I think if it weren't for Cliff and the whole organization, I wouldn't care about much. It's like he took me under his wing before I became a troubled teen and there's no way I could ever be able to thank him with words.**99** 

We are so proud of this young lady, who made the honor roll in her high school classes this year and continues to come out and volunteer with us.

**66** I grew up with the Superkids program. When I was five I started going to the BBQs and then eventually Superkids started up every Saturday at a church up the hill from my house. Cliff started running camp and it was something I looked forward to every year.







## ló years with Extreme Outreach



nother beautiful sunny day in Victoria Cliff Power and I walked out of his scruffy little room in "Holiday Court Motel" and began to walk down the sidewalk, when a woman approached us. She was desperate, in a hurry. She had no shoes, a rumpled little dress. Her hair was a mess and she had sores on her arms, face, and feet. To be honest, the first thing I felt was shock and repulsion, then grief and pity, with no sense of how to respond, other than to look the other way. This surprised me because, after years of pasturing Victoria Harvest Church I was used to being around the marginalized poor, who found our informality, compassion and acceptance, a safe place to come. But at this moment I didn't know what to do. Even though I had compassion I was emotionally and physically immobilized because I didn't know how to help or step across the "bridge" into her world.

Cliff, on the other hand, knew her, and stepped toward her saying "I see that little smile." And sure enough a tiny smile peeked through the pain and urgency on her face. She knew he authentically cared. He connected with her and she gave him a very rare gift... trust. She hurried past us to the motel to get a fix, to feel better, to find a "John," to get some money, to get a fix... and so on.

I had known Cliff for years. He attended our church. He is a man on a mission with a BIG vision. At this moment I got a glimpse of how extraordinary he was, his depth of compassion and how easily he crossed that "bridge" most of us don't want to because of fear, or don't know how. That was Cliff doing what Jesus did. Months before we had rented a room that had become empty because the tenant died of an overdose and eventually Cliff moved in to the place Victoria Police said it is the worst place in the City.

Who we didn't expect to encounter, were the children of the adults associated with the motel. It wasn't long before Cliff had lots of young people around him. He became aware of the very difficult home lives for many of them, their parents hopelessly gripped by addiction and the accompanying lifestyle. He knew these kids were heading in the same direction, but not quite there yet and he had faith they could be reached before they were. Our loving Father in heaven was planting the seeds for the vision for "Super Kids."

Some years later a brave wonderful woman who had a heart and gifting for children jumped on board Cliff's vision (speeding train). She was in love with what Cliff was doing and fell in love with him, and he with her. Cliff and Andrea were joined together in marriage and ministry.

During those beginning days, months, and years the foundational values, character, and ministry of "Extreme Outreach" were developed and continue on to this day.

What a ride! What an adventure it has been. So many stories of the redeeming love of God touching the lives of children and their families through the "Super Kids" program, "Super Kids camp, Community Christmas dinners, and other events.

I tell this story because it is an example of a significant part of the ministry of Extreme Outreach. Cliff is a person who is not afraid to cross the bridge and go to the less fortunate, hurting, and those in need. According to Ephesians 4:11-13 God gives gifted people to the church who's responsibility is to equip and give opportunity/make a way for God's people to do His work and build up the church. It takes hundreds of volunteers every year to fulfill God's compassionate ministry through Extreme Outreach. These volunteers are individuals, people from organizations, schools, businesses, and from churches. There are so many things to do and ways to serve, anyone can be involved, from pastoral care to waiting on tables, administration to face to face with a child, small and large financial contributions - one time gift to monthly contributions. Extreme Outreach gives you the opportunity to participate in a compassionate outreach bringing hope to the lives of children and families in Greater Victoria Area.
