Our certified organic coffee beans arrive farmer direct from the famous Chiapas region of Southern Mexico and are then masterfully roasted locally. Our baristas prepare a large variety of drinks, ranging from black drip coffee to multiple specialty drinks, like tasty mochas.

We serve fresh sandwiches and delicious baked goods daily, as well as soup and chili in the fall and winter months. Our baker does such an amazing job you'll want to try one of everything! All food and drink purchases remain 100% by donation. Proceeds after expenses go to support our programs. Who knew a simple cup of coffee could make such an impact! ♥

rom a young age, I've loved working with kids and have been interested in mission work. In 2012, when I was 14, I went on my first missions trip, a weeklong service trip to a little town in Alberta. Being surrounded by people my age with amazing serving hearts sparked my interest to continue pursuing mission work. I'd planned to do the service trip again, but it was expensive, even with all the fundraising our group did. Just before the summer of 2013, someone from my church shared that Extreme Outreach was still looking for volunteers for their summer camp. This sounded like fun and allowed me to do local outreach work. So, my older sister and I signed up to volunteer for the SuperKids Summer Camp. My younger siblings and other kids I knew from other low-income housing places would also be attending as campers.

We arrived on Saturday to help set up. I didn't know what to expect, but I was very excited to volunteer. I was placed in the kitchen for the week. Even though the kitchen takes a lot of hard work, I left camp absolutely in love with the kids and the work being done with them. I volunteered for the other programs Extreme ran throughout the year. Each new outreach showed me that it was the kind of thing I wanted to do with my life.

Volunteering with Extreme gave me the confidence to pursue a gap year program after graduating. I was blessed with the opportunity to do 2 years of The Year Out with Youth for Christ UK. The first year I focused on local youth outreach where I lived. Where I lived has been described as one of the most deprived places in the Greater Manchester area. The youth we worked with had very similar situations to the SuperKids families in Victoria. Although I did have to miss the Annual Christmas Dinners while I was in the UK, I made it work to come home for SuperKids Summer Camp both years.

When talking to Cliff about the work I was doing in the UK, he got very excited about all I was learning. He offered me the Admin position at Extreme when I got home in mid-2019. I got home the day before the start of camp in 2019 and went up to camp the next day around the same time the kids got there and cabin lead (while mildly jet-lagged) for the week. A few days after camp, I started working at Extreme and have been going strong ever since, even through the pandemic. After seeing a generation of kids grow up at the outreaches, I was very excited to have the chance to work with Extreme. Being a part of the hardwork that makes these outreaches happen adds another level of joy to seeing the kids smiling faces. ♥
