## COFFEE WITH A CAUSE

**N**estled in a quiet corner of View Royal, our Extreme Coffee House has been open for 7 years. Since the beginning, we've been a peaceful and welcoming place for everyone. We are excited to reopen our indoor seating to the public, including our Kids Corner full of toys and games!

Our coffee beans are now from Galloping Goose Coffee, which buys the coffee from smallholder farmers through their long-term trusted trade relationships, paying the best price for their coffee. Here at home, they are meticulous about roasting. This ensures sustainability for farmers and traders as well as a great cup of coffee for you. Certifications at origins include Fairtrade, organic and Rainforest Alliance. Our baristas prepare a large variety of drinks, ranging from black drip coffee to multiple specialty drinks, like tasty mochas.

We serve fresh sandwiches and delicious baked goods daily, as well as soup and chili in the fall and winter months. Our baker does such an amazing job you'll want to try one of everything! All food and drink purchases remain 100% by donation. Proceeds after expenses go to support our programs. Who knew a simple cup of coffee could make such an impact! ♥

## Community Outreach

**F**or most kids, enjoying a family BBQ, an outdoor adventure, or attending a fun workshop is part of normal childhood development and growing up in a healthy community. However, for marginalized or at-risk children, these opportunities are not easy to come by – activities that we often take for granted can be costly for families who cannot pay for them. Sometimes, parents who are struggling with responsibility and life skills don't realize that these activities are an important part of growing up.

Our weekly BBQ ministry is held at low-cost housing complexes, home to many at-risk children and youth. Over the years, Extreme Outreach has developed many life-long relationships, while inspiring children to cook and cooperate with each other. The BBQ is full of fun, energy and happiness as the children and their community gather to eat and play together. The BBQ starts with some of the regular attendee volunteers, eagerly waiting for Cliff to pull up in the bus and unload supplies. From there, they help with everything from putting smokies on the grill, to setting up buns and treats. The children are taught how to cook safely and with the best sanitary practices, giving them confidence that they can take home to their own families. While they take turns on the BBQ, they connect with Cliff and the other outreach volunteers, all while joking around and having fun. When the food is ready, the children blow a horn to let the community know. For some, this will be the first and/or only meal of the day. It is also one of the only times that the whole community comes together like this. The weekly BBQ Outreach helps build the heart of Community. ♥

# Before Extreme

*"They hit me," you will say, "but I'm not hurt! They beat me, but I don't feel it! When will I wake so I can find another drink?"* Proverbs 23:35.

Unfortunately, that's how I lived my life growing up in Langford, where you were nothing unless you knew how to party. My goal was to be the best party animal the world has ever known. What a mistake! I don't recommend this goal to anyone.

It came to an end when I hit rock bottom one day. I was ready and trying to die. I had no hope at all. After praying with tears streaming down my face, saying, "God, if you are real, please help me", a miracle saved me, and I was completely covered by the purest love I've ever felt, and I opened my heart to Jesus. That's when the transformation began to happen. I've been straight since that experience on November 17, 1987. 35 years now, and no matter what I do, I give God all the glory. Without experiencing His love, Extreme wouldn't exist.

It has been a crazy ride but a good one. God uses my past now to encourage others to know Him. I started Extreme Outreach Society, and now we're celebrating 25 years.

## THE FIRST 5 YEARS



Residents at the motel could not always celebrate birthdays due to living in a non-stop crisis. We made it a point to celebrate with them. Tears flowed many times.

The first 5 years focused on helping the people who lived at Holiday Court Motel, Victoria's main epicentre of crime. It was previously a tired tourist hotel but had become the unofficial transition house for the drug-addicted, prostituted, and just plain out of luck. I quit my drywall career and moved into room 21. My goal was to love the residents there, yet much more began to happen. Slowly I gained the trust of the people in the motel, and their lives began to change. I brought them to treatment centres, taught drywall, helped with job placements, and started a teen basketball team. The constant police presence, overdoses, and fights were starting to fade until they were no longer present. The motel was eventually sold and torn down. To my surprise, where my room 21 had been, there's now a continuously flowing 3-pillar fountain.



## BBQ OUTREACH

The BBQ outreach began at Holiday Court Motel outside of room 21, when I would grill up burgers for hungry tenants to eat a real meal for free. After the motel was gone, I turned my attention to a nearby low-income housing complex that had been a breeding ground for teen drug users in the past. I began my BBQ outreach on the basketball courts at a school nearby, hoping to build relationships with vulnerable teens who might be considering or dealing with drug abuse. Instead, I found a community of young children potentially at risk due to their surroundings. Through this outreach, I began meeting their families. As we got to know the kids, we saw the need to connect with them more often and developed the SuperKids Saturdays and Camp programs. The BBQ outreach continues to this day. Kids learn how to BBQ and serve their community, which builds their confidence.

## 2005

Around 2005, Extreme Outreach purchased 8 houses on McKenzie Avenue to provide a safe, drug-free place for those transitioning out of rehab centres and the like. We also ran an Extreme thrift store for 2 years, had 50 gumball machines in businesses, and owned

The Shepherd's Guide to help raise funds to help pay the \$15,800/month mortgage. Miraculously, we never missed a payment! However, after 5 years of being extremely short-staffed and running all of that, we began to burn out. So I shut down the thrift store and sold the gumball business and The Shepherd's Guide. It was time to turn our focus to breaking the cycle of poverty, homelessness, and addiction before it begins and continue to do outreaches for the kids.

Eventually, the recovery house ministry was closed down, and we sold the houses and paid off the \$2.3 million mortgage, providing a fresh start for a new season. We all deserved an "I survived!" T-shirt after this. It was really hard to let go of that vision, but I had to. I always seem to be a million short of fulfilling the vision in my heart.



## SUPERKIDS

As time went on, the focus of the ministry transformed to the younger generation, mainly 6 to 12-year-olds. We started our SuperKids Saturday outreach in 2003, where we fed the kids lunch, played games, sang songs, and shared encouragement with them. We need a new home for this outreach.

## WARM A SOUL

Warm A Soul started 25 years ago with 25 stockings for the homeless. Now they are given to children in need, as well as First Nations communities, and those in local shelters, detox sites, and living on our streets – those who may not otherwise receive a gift at Christmas. It's amazing. We put together and give away more than 1,000 stockings each year, with a record of 1610. This is made possible by people like you, either making a stocking or making a donation for us to make a stocking on your behalf.

## CHRISTMAS DINNER

Alongside our regular programs, we love to surprise our kids by organizing great new adventures. Many of the kids we reach out to do not have the means to participate in local adventure programs, trips, or organized sports. We are grateful to provide these life-changing opportunities. Our adventures have included surfing, sailing, hiking, movie outings, hockey games, and more.

## EXTREME COFFEE HOUSE

Two years after the sale of the houses, we purchased a space for our office for \$250,000. That brought our bank balance to 0. This was another start to a new adventure called Extreme Coffee House. We've been running the Coffee House and our office there for 7 years now. It has been remarkable to see the number of youth we have been able to train. We are the first by-donation Coffee House as far as I know.

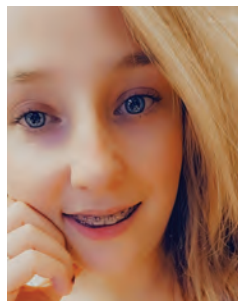

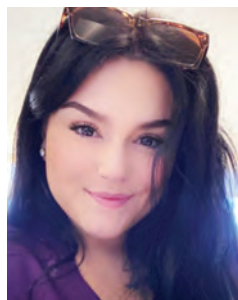

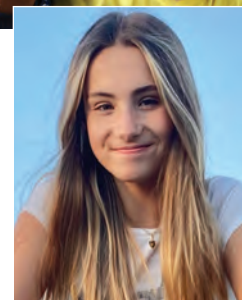
