Nestled in a quiet corner of View Royal, our Extreme Coffee House has been open for 9 years. This welcoming space comes complete with a beloved Kids Corner full of books, games, and toys for kids of all ages.

Our coffee beans are from Galloping Goose Coffee, which buys the coffee from smallholder farmers through their long-term trusted trade relationships, paying the best price for their coffee. Here at home, they are meticulous about roasting. This ensures sustainability for farmers and traders as well as a great cup of coffee for you. Certifications at origins include Fairtrade, organic and Rainforest Alliance. Our baristas prepare a large variety of drinks, ranging from black drip coffee to multiple specialty drinks, like tasty mochas.

We serve fresh sandwiches and delicious baked goods daily, as well as soup and chili during non-summer months. Our baker does such an amazing job you'll want to try one of everything! All food and drink purchases remain 100% by donation.

BBQ Outreach

Nevaeh's Story

"Cliff and I first met when I was 5 years old when I visited one of his BBQs in my neighbourhood. I had five siblings, so whenever I went to get hot dogs, I would bring a giant cookie tray for all of the hot dogs my family ate. It became an inside joke, and I grew to admire Cliff's free-spirited nature and amazing sense of humour. His BBQs provided a sense of connection for many families while also fueling individuals who may not have had access to basic necessities. From here, I discovered that he runs kids camps, so at the age of 5, I snuck into a kids camp for ages 6–12 and had the time of my life making new friends and participating in activities that I couldn't do at home.

As I grew older, I began to have significant problems with my mental health and was hospitalized for about a year at the age of 11 as a result. Throughout this time, Cliff and Andrea made sure to check on me and assist me with any resources I might have required. Summer camps began to feel like an escape for me; every year, I would go to camp for a week and temporarily forget about my struggles. During the week of camp, I also got the opportunity to connect with the leaders and develop real connections with people older than me, which is crucial for children, especially those who need a positive role model.

My experience with the Extreme Outreach Society has improved my communication skills and made it simpler for me to engage and be social. Because of my mental health, I have always struggled to interact with others, but since meeting Cliff and Andrea, I have come out of my shell and been able to make a positive influence in my community. When I was 10, I began volunteering as a barista at the Coffee House; 7 years and 1336 volunteer hours later, I am still volunteering at the cafe; it has been a vital part of my growth. I've learned about responsibilities and what it's like in the workplace. This has given me a lot of confidence when hunting for work because I know what to expect and am able to bring my A game.

That brings us to today, where I am a recent graduate trying to find my footing in the world, and with the experiences I have under my belt and the assurance that I will have infinite support from Extreme Outreach, I am able to navigate this new world confidently and ready for the next challenge. When I pursue my future job as a pediatric nurse, I will reflect on my childhood and remember all of the memories that have led me to my future, and I will be eternally grateful to this organization for everything it has done for me. Thank you, Andrea, Cliff, and all of the other workers for everything you've done for me and the other kids in Victoria." ❤️
